Iconic Pennzoil Place Wins Local 'The Outstanding Building of the Year' Award!

ennzoil Place is the proud winner of the 2015/2016 Houston Building Owners and Managers Association (BOMA) The Outstanding Building of the Year (TOBY) Award in the Over One Million Square Feet Category. Members of the hard working Transwestern property management team received the prestigious award at the Houston TOBY Award dinner in January.

Each year, the TOBY is awarded to the highest scoring building in each of 15 categories, beginning at the local level. The categories consist of five square footage awards ranging from under 100,000 square feet to over one million square feet, along with categories for medical, corporate, historic, low-rise and mid-rise suburban office park, government, renovated, retail, industrial office park, and an Earth Award category.

Local judging consists of a building inspection by a panel of judges guided by the property management



team. Judges are introduced to the building's energy efficient systems, tenant amenities, and environmentally friendly features during the tour.

Among other prerequisites, each competing building must benchmark energy usage through the EPA ENERGY STAR® website. Buildings with an energy benchmark score of 60 or higher receive additional points. Having received the 2016 ENERGY STAR designation with a benchmark

score of 85, Pennzoil Place easily received these coveted bonus points.

Congratulations to the Transwestern Pennzoil Place management team for garnering the TOBY Award. The team worked hard to prepare for the competition while completing daily building operations and providing the high standards of tenant service Pennzoil Place tenants have come to expect.

LEED® Dynamic Plaque - Performance Monitoring & More

ennzoil Place aarnered the prestiaious Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Gold certification in 2011. Under the normal LEED process, properties must go through a re-certification process every five years. In keeping with ownership and management's forward thinking, energy conservation and environmental initiatives and building improvements over the years, the Pennzoil Place team is using the cutting edge LEED Dynamic Plaque building performance monitoring and scoring platform for its 2016 LEED Gold re-certification.

What Is LEED & The LEED Dynamic Plaque?

Governed by the U.S. Green Building Council® (USGBC), LEED is an internationally recognized program that provides third-party verification of green buildings and equips building owners and operators with a framework for identifying and implementing practical and measurable green building design, construction, operations and maintenance solutions. Participation in the voluntary LEED process demonstrates leadership, innovation, environmental stewardship and social responsibility. As of August, 2015, 13.8 billion square feet of building space participate in the LEED rating system. Houston is currently 3rd in the nation by LEED certified square footage and 8th by number of LEED projects.

The LEED Dynamic Plaque[™] is a building performance monitoring and scoring platform. It measures building performance across five categories: energy, water, waste, transportation and human experience, and generates a current performance score (out of 100) which is updated as new building data enters the platform. The performance score corresponds with the globally recognized LEED certification levels (40-49 = Certified, 50-59 = Silver, 60-79 = Gold, 80+ = Platinum).

The software is designed to enable building owners, facilities managers, consultants and other team members to observe trends and make meaningful improvements to building operations that save money, resources and make building occupants



more comfortable. The powerful performance software enables users to track current and historic performance, input and update data, view trends, and manage projects. The data collected through the LEED Dynamic Plaque software is applied toward LEED re-certification, allowing properties to conveniently re-certify each year.


How Does LEED Certification Benefit The Building, Its Tenants & The Environment?

LEED buildings are more efficient, leave a smaller carbon footprint, and provide a more healthful working environment. Again, the higher the level of certification, the greater the benefits for the tenants and the environment. LEED Gold buildings consume 25% less energy, use 11% less water, have 19% lower maintenance costs, 27% higher occupant satisfaction, and produce 34% less greenhouse gas emissions compared to the average commercial building. LEED building occupants are more satisfied with their work environment's green features such as healthy indoor air quality, energy conservation lighting controls, and energy efficient practices.

How Can Tenants Help?

Your participation in completing the Transportation Survey assisted with the building's LEED transportation assessment and score, earning us nine points toward our total LEED score. Your continued participation in building programs, such as recycling, benefits the Pennzoil Place environment and local and global environments and aids the property management team in garnering recognition for our clean, efficient, and modern building through the LEED program.

t's time to get outdoors and enjoy the warm weather. Why not do some mid-day grocery shopping for locally grown produce and enjoy an al fresco lunch nearby?

2016 City Hall Farmers Market Wednesdays through June 29 11 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. Hermann Square front of City Hall

The popular City Hall Farmers Market recently made its annual springtime re-appearance. You'll be able to take advantage of this seasonal, pop-up market every Wednesday now through June 29th. Located on the City Hall grounds along both sides of the reflection pool, the market features locally grown produce and a variety of locally prepared foods. More than 30 vendors offering breads, cheeses, roasted coffees, a variety of prepared foods and fresh produce grown by local farmers, along with food trucks, offer a variety of choices for a small grocery shopping trip, a ready-to-eat lunch, or a tasty morsel packaged to take back to the office.

The Market is a short walk from Pennzoil Place - take the purple

tunnel toward Two Shell Plaza, the red toward One Shell Plaza, and the blue tunnel toward Tranquility Park/City Hall. If you prefer walking above ground, it's only three blocks to City Hall - Louisiana to Walker to Bagby! Those coming from outside downtown can select metered street parking or garage parking at Tranquility Park Garage (400 Rusk) or Hobby Center (800 Bagby). The City Hall Farmers Market is wheelchair-accessible.

- Close all office doors.

This information should be provided immediately and should always be kept current.
